

Ace of Pentacles

Upright: A new financial or career opportunity, manifestation, abundance Reversed: Lost opportunity, lack of planning and foresight

Ace of Pentacles, like other Aces of the Tarot, represents new beginnings, opportunities, and potential. As a Pentacles card, these new beginnings correlate to the material world: finances, wealth, career, physical health and manifestation of your goals. Ace of Pentacles heralds a sense of prosperity and abundance in the material or financial areas of your life. As with all Aces in the Tarot deck, this card illustrates the possibility of a new endeavor but does not guarantee its manifestation or success. This is up to you. Keep your eyes open for chances to manifest your goals and realize your inner potential.

Ace of Pentacles has a green pentacle and a dead apple "tree of knowledge." This tree depicts the Dia de los Muertos theme of death and rebirth, as the tree is coming to life with a new branch of green leaves (a new beginning, rebirth, new potential) and a red apple (fruit of labor, effort, or wealth.) This Ace signifies abundance in all areas of your life. Ace of Pentacles symbolizes wealth in a broader sense-happiness, fulfillment, potential, and love. Feel blessed and deserving. Live by the Law of Attraction and send your positive energy and intent into the Universe so you will receive more in return.

In occult uses of Tarot, the Coins suit is considered part of the "Minor Arcana" and may alternately be known as "Pentacles." In divinatory usage, the suit is connected with the classical element of Earth, the physical body, and possessions or wealth. All three "earth" zodiacs, Taurus, Virgo, Capricorn, are added here. The Earth element is one of rooting in, crafting, and conserving and is highly connected to the senses. Have you ever heard someone described as "earthy?" The term usually describes people who are grounded and oriented to what is "real;" they are able to easily get a handle on and face an entire situation quickly and nimbly. This trait often makes them very productive and able to create tangible results.

Two of Pentacles

Upright: Multiple priorities, time management, prioritization, adaptability Reversed: Over-committed, disorganization, re-prioritization

When Two of Pentacles appears in a Tarot reading, you are juggling your priorities and responsibilities. In the upright position, this card notes you are doing an excellent job of balancing these different priorities, but this Two reminds you that the line between coping and losing control is thin. Two of Pentacles invites you to manage your time and your priorities carefully. This card calls your awareness to the concept of balance and those parts of your life where you have it (and those where you don't). While you can strive for equilibrium, nothing ever stays in perfect harmony. When Two of Pentacles appears in a Tarot reading, see it as a reminder to be patient, flexible, and adaptable as you try to juggle your responsibilities with your family, friends, work, finances, health, and new challenges.

Two of Pentacles has a traditional Tarot image here. It is in the Art Nouveau style, showing the concept of duality, twins, balance, and a turbulent ocean. Two of Pentacles can appear when you are getting caught up in the day-to-day demands and losing sight of the bigger picture. Ask yourself: What life do I want? How can I reorganize my schedule to create the life I desire?

The symbol for Taurus represents the face and horns of a bull. Taurus is an Earth sign and has the ability to see things from a grounded, practical, and realistic perspective. What we often see as stubbornness can be interpreted as commitment. The Taurus ability to complete tasks, whatever it takes, is uncanny.



Three of Pentacles

Upright: Teamwork, collaboration, learning, implementation Reversed: Disharmony, misalignment, working alone

When Three of Pentacles turns up in a Tarot reading, take it as a sign to collaborate with others, creating synergies to achieve big results. Three of Pentacles represents the value of different ideas and levels of experience in collaboration. Even though backgrounds, experience levels, and expertise are very different, they can come together to share their insight in a way that creates synergy and improves the finished product. You will also learn from each member of the team when you see his or her unique contribution. As you implement your plans, you will realize that you have the skills, capabilities, and resources you need to accomplish your objectives!

Three of Pentacles has a woman in the steam-punk styling of her undertakers' dress which brings in a subtle death and Dia de los Muertos connection. She has an intent gaze as she focuses forward towards her goal. The clockwork represents the smooth workings to completion of a goal. The green pentacles are an indication of the earth element and the resources available to her should she choose to use them.

Taurus is the bull who steadily charges forward towards the goal. Remember, each person has an important role to play. When you come together as a team, you can create something much more significant than if you were to undertake the project on your own.



Four of Pentacles - Cuatro de Pentaculos

Upright: Saving money, security, conservatism, scarcity, control Reversed: Over-spending, greed, self-protection

Four of Pentacles generates both positive and negative perceptions. On the one hand, this card signifies you have accomplished many of your goals and have attained great material wealth in the process. On the other hand, there is a risk that you will come to value only material wealth. Although this card shows a practical and financially stable person, it often indicates possessiveness, greed, and an overly cautious approach to life. You may be afraid to take risks, both financially and emotionally, for fear of losing everything you have attained so far. As a result, you may be vaguely unhappy and unfulfilled. Are you letting something hold you back from your true purpose? Is your desire for control and stability keeping you from seeking your truth? Perhaps your current path to wealth doesn't serve your true needs. Think about the sacrifices made when we are focused only on surface wealth or material. Are you finding a deep, fulfilling kind of wealth that is in line with your spiritual self?

The traditional Spanish religious symbol, Our Lady of Guadalupe or Blessed Virgin, represents the spiritual self here. She is in her typical position while holding the Pentacles, which symbolize coins or some kind of wealth. In the Tarot Muertos, she blends with the Day of the Dead Santa Muerte, a female deity in Mexican and Mexican-American folk Catholicism. A personification of death, Santa Muerte is associated with healing, protection, and safe delivery to the afterlife. Her elaborate jewelry and robes further the indication of wealth.

Her robes are green, an indication of the earth element. As well, embedded in the image is the Virgo astrological symbol of the virgin maiden, Astraea, who is associated with wheat and Earth. Astraea was the last immortal to abandon Earth at the end of the Silver Age, when the gods fled to Olympus. She was the "star maiden" and the goddess of innocence. Her presence here acts as a guidepost to your truest self.



Five of Pentacles Upright: Financial loss, poverty, lack mindset, isolation, worry Reversed: Recovery from financial loss, spiritual poverty Five of Pentacles is a card of financial loss. You have hit hard times, especially when it comes to your finances and material possessions. Your ego may also be bruised, especially since success often correlates to financial wealth. You no longer feel safe. The upside is that this is a Minor Arcana card with temporary effects (rather than a Major Arcana card which has a longer-term impact). This, too, shall pass. In this time of need, Five of Pentacles indicates you feel isolated and alone. It may appear as if no one cares anymore. You may be waiting for someone to come and help you when really, you need to be proactive and ask for help. You need to swallow your pride or let go of your fear of rejection and reach out. People are here to support you. Find them and let them know you need them.

A traditional Tarot image, Five of Pentacles, in her hooded figure, represents isolation. The steam-punk styled clockwork represents her anxiety and fear as time keeps moving forward. All you can see is what is going wrong. To shift this energy, look for evidence of what you do have-even if it's very small or seemingly insignificant-and express your gratitude. Over time, the positive aspects will continue to grow. Redirect your attention to what you have now and what you want in the future, so your manifesting powers get used for good.

Capricorn is a sign that represents time and responsibility, and its representatives are traditional and often very serious by nature. These individuals possess an inner state of independence. They are masters of self-control. They will learn from their mistakes and get to the top based solely on their experience and expertise. Called "The Goat of Fear," Capricorn speaks of each natural chain reaction of fear, where one scary thing leads to many others, rising up as defensive mechanisms that only make things worse. Immersed in their secrecy, they face the world just as they are-brave enough to never run away, but constantly afraid of their inner monsters.



Six Pentacles

Upright: Giving, receiving, sharing wealth, generosity, charity Reversed: Self-care, unpaid debts, one-sided charity

You have accumulated great wealth and are now in a position to offer financial assistance to those in need. Six of Pentacles is a card representing financial harmony. The amounts flowing in and out are in balance, and you are thankful for what you have and happy to share with others in need. Even if you are not financially wealthy, you offer up your time, energy, love, and support to those who are in need, knowing it will be appreciated. Giving of your time or your wisdom is often just as spiritually fulfilling as giving away money or gifts, and the intangible gift of your presence is received just as well, if not better. There may be times when you wonder if you can truly afford to give generously to others-and the wise advice of Six of Pentacles is to trust that every contribution you make is valued and will come back to you threefold.

In Six of Pentacles, there is a traditional, Mexican, Dia de los Muertos-styled portrait of a beautiful and wise woman with a look of knowing. She is surrounded by fragrant lilies, roses, and six green pentacles showing her wealth-financial, time, or gained wisdom. The scales indicate her balance as she realizes sharing her wealth (financial or other) with others is key because of the joy and contentment it can bring. The Zodiac symbol for Capricorn is tattooed on her wrist.

Capricorn is a sign that represents time and responsibility, and its representatives are traditional and often very serious by nature. These individuals possess an inner state of independence that enables significant progress both in their personal and professional lives. They are masters of self-control and have the ability to lead the way, make solid and realistic plans, and manage many people who work for them at any time. They will learn from their mistakes and get to the top based solely on their experience and expertise.



Seven of Pentacles

Upright: Vision, perseverance, reward, investment Reversed: Lack of long-term vision, limited success or reward

Seven of Pentacles shows you understand the value of putting in time and energy, both now and for longer-term rewards. You are putting your attention on the right areas instead of wasting time and effort on tasks that will not deliver any value. Rest assured, your hard work will pay off. When this card appears in a Tarot reading, see it as an invitation to step back from the day-to-day and look at the bigger picture. Celebrate what you have created and assess your progress so far.

Six of Pentacles has a traditional yet modern take on classic Tarot imagery. Seven green pentacles on a dead tree give a nod to Dia de los Muertos and Earth symbolism. The girl has picked the fruit (apple with pentacle) of her hard work or labor and seems satisfied with the results. Sometimes, however, Seven of Pentacles can indicate frustration with slow results. You have been laboring away at something important, and you may feel concerned that your efforts will go unrewarded. Be patient and appreciate the progress you have made so far. The endeavor or project is near its culmination. While there are no guarantees, be grateful, and focus on the present.

Intelligent and sophisticated, Virgo gets the job done. Practical Virgos are incredibly adept at big picture thinking and planning out their life. They have a sense of control and security. Virgo's desire to have everything be perfect can manifest in frustration when life doesn't live up to those (sometimes unrealistic) expectations. Virgo is incredibly hard working. When this sign wants something, it will work for it. Bottom line: Virgos work hard, and that work ethic inspires everyone in their life.

Eight of Pentacles

Upright: Apprenticeship, mastery, skill development, education, engagement Reversed: Self-development, perfectionism, misdirected activity

Eight of Pentacles represents apprenticeship and mastery. When this card appears in a Tarot reading, you are working to improve your skills and become a master at what you do. You are diligent, hard-working, and applying yourself fully to whatever has your attention. As you do the same task over and over, you work your way towards mastery of your craft. Through perseverance and unwavering attention, you create success. Eight of Pentacles is encouragement to keep doing what you are doing, as it will eventually lead to success.

This card has traditional and modern Tarot imagery. In this image, you can see a female figure covered in paint. Her attention is absorbed inward as she strives towards perfection, indicated by the almost perfect circle of pink paint. A paint brush and dream catcher with peacock feathers represent her hopes, dreams, and desires. There are seven green pentacles encircling her. The Capricorn symbol is set behind her on the dream catcher. Yes, it requires a lot of dedication, focus, and patience, but as each day passes and you stay true to your values and beliefs, you get a little closer to your goal. It may not be as apparent as you may like, but events are unfolding that will lead you to the right path.

Capricorns are determined and ambitious people who want to reach the top to get the reward. Capricorns set high standards for themselves, but their honesty, dedication, and perseverance will lead them to attain their goals. They value loyalty and hard work over all other things. In tune with their personal goals, Capricorns can lack compassion and emotion when relating to their loved ones. Concentrated and resourceful, Capricorns get the job done, don't mind long hours, and commit to the final product completely.

Nine of Pentacles



Nine of Pentacles

Upright: Abundance, luxury, self-sufficiency, financial independence Reversed: Self-worth, over-investment in work, hustling

Nine of Pentacles speaks of financial independence. When Nine of Pentacles appears in a Tarot reading, do not be afraid to splurge, indulge, or pamper yourself, especially as a reward for all of your hard work. You have worked hard to create abundance in your life, and Nine of Pentacles says you can finally enjoy the fruits of your labor. Invest wisely and seek financial advice to make the most of your wealth. While the suit of Pentacles typically focuses on material wealth and gain, this card also suggests that you are in harmony with the environment around you. You appreciate the beauty and abundance found in nature and your surroundings. You can harness this high-vibe energy to bring pleasure into your life. Having achieved so much and maybe not be at the finish line just yet, this is your opportunity to acknowledge your achievements and re-energize yourself for the final phase.

The woman of this card has created a luxurious lifestyle by her own actions and efforts. Nine of Pentacles is an independent woman, she does not rely on others for financial support or her success. With nine green pentacles and a grape arbor heavy with grapes, she is holding a hawk as well-indicating wealth and luxury. While the suit of Pentacles typically focuses on material wealth and gain, this card also suggests that the woman is in harmony with her environment, filled with gratitude and appreciation for the beauty and abundance surrounding her. She has worked hard and reacted a state of peace with her station in life.

Persistent and hardworking, once a Taurus sets a goal, it will get done-despite any obstacles that may come up. Taurus has an intense internal drive with a reputation as one of the hardest-working signs in the Zodiac. A bull is never afraid to roll up those sleeves and get to work. A common Taurus motto, nothing worth having comes easy, sums up this bull symbol (or even a bulldozer). They're also a model for perseverance-when a bull decides to do something, it gets it done.

Now you can now share this wealth with others. When Ten of Pentacles appears in a Tarot reading, you are surrounded by wealth and blessed with financial abundance. There is no wanting for any more. You have everything you need-especially within the material realm. You are financially secure. You express sincere gratitude for fulfilling your material goals and dreams.

Ten of Pentacles shows a woman holding a skull representing the end of a cycle. Death also has a presence in the skulls in her tattoos. She is encircled by ten green pentacles, representing coins or good fortune. This is a culmination and final fulfillment, a point of completion and accomplishment in your journey. Your path has come to an end and you have fulfilled your obligations and purpose in this world. Your have reached a place of peace and acceptance and are now prepared for death. Ten of Pentacles is also a sign that family is very important to you. You are also strongly connected to your family history and heritage, a part of the long lineage that goes before you. You will now join your ancestors that have gone before you to the world beyond, you accept this and are now ready. It represents tradition, being a part of something bigger and realizing that the blood of your ancestors flows through your veins.

The Zodiac sign of Capricorn is engraved on the skull. Capricorn is a sign that represents time and responsibility, and its symbols are traditional in nature. This is a sign with full understanding for family traditions. Capricorn also understand that sages die too. They tend to grow old and die from natural causes. Death related with Capricorn is a death which has an impact in society. Capricorn attracts power and its death equals a change of an era.



Daughter of Pentacles

Upright: Manifestation, financial opportunity, skill development Reversed: Lack of progress, procrastination, learn from failure

Daughter of Pentacles, like the Daughters of all four Tarot suits, brings a welcome message of new beginnings, inspiration, and the initial stages of a creative project or venture. When Daughter of Pentacles appears in a Tarot reading, you are tapping into your ability to manifest a personal goal or dream and may be in the midst of a new project, business venture, or the start of a new educational experience. You are excited about the possibilities and potential of what you put your mind to, knowing you can create whatever you want with focused intention and action. However, this Daughter does not specify the fulfillment of dreams as much as the initial motivation and energy to begin the process of turning those dreams to reality. You need to stay focused on the practical and tangible elements, keeping your feet planted on the ground, always looking for the next realistic and achievable step forward. Your common sense and a pragmatic approach will lead you to a solution that works.

Daughter of Pentacles holds a Spanish style fan and wears face paint. She has a traditional Dia de los Muertos head-dress, and the fan is a light spring green color. The green Pentacle suggests new wealth-material or otherwise. She looks a bit self-conscious with her body, or new womanhood. Pentacles correspond to the alchemical element of Earth, and in this sense the coin that the Daughter holds may symbolize the beginnings of sensual awareness.

Most myths generally view Virgo as a virgin/maiden. The symbolism behind the name speaks well of the Virgo nature, born with a feeling they are experiencing everything for the first time. The sign of Virgo is easily attached to the symbolism of a virgin, cautious when it comes to starting new relationships. She will never simply give herself to someone without assessing their character and emotions shared with her from the beginning.

Warrior of Pentacles

Warrior of Pentacles, like the Warriors of the other suits, represents work, effort, and the responsibility that follows upon the dreams and ideals of the Daughters. When this card appears in a Tarot reading, you are working methodically towards your goals. You have a plan in place and are sticking to your schedule to get the job done. You may not work particularly quickly, but you are consistent, dedicated, and committed to your goal. With Warrior of Pentacles, you will be required to accept responsibility without any complaints or grudges, and you will never leave a job half done. Warrior of Pentacles envisions a goal, determines the best course of action, and then sticks to a path with a methodical and relentless focus.

Warrior of Pentacles embodies brute force and work-both methodical and physical. He knows what is ahead and charges forth anyway. With his Aztec/Mayan skull headdress and shield with skull tattoos, this Warrior represents a relentless attitude. He is unafraid of the work involved or the sometimes mundane, charging forth. With a battle cry, he is prepared for to turn those ideas/dreams into reality.

Patience is a virtue and the Taurus possesses it aplenty. Tauruses believe in doing the job right rather than being the first one finished with the job. Once they set their eyes on something, Tauruses will persistently put in all the efforts to get it done right. Failures and setbacks rarely dampen their spirits.

Queen of Pentacles

Queen of Pentacles is the nurturing mother of the material world. Queen of Pentacles represents prosperity and security. You have worked hard to generate a level of financial or physical security, which in turn gives you the ability to be generous with others and to share your wealth and abundance with those you love. You have used your financial prosperity to build a comfortable home environment and are as focused on investing in your family as your personal wealth. When Queen of Pentacles appears in a Tarot reading, you are embodying the ultimate working parent archetype. You care for your family and domestic responsibilities while also making a living for yourself and creating financial abundance. You can maintain a healthy balance between home and work by integrating the two and finding your place of flow and alignment.

For Queen of Pentacles, the green pentacle is placed behind her head as a sort of crown. She has the traditional Dia de los Muertos face paint and ceremonial roses adorning her hair, though she is a modern woman with tattoo sleeves and a leather bustier. This Queen asks you to maintain a compassionate, nurturing, practical, and down-to-earth attitude when dealing with others and your present circumstances. Focus on creating a calm and balanced life for yourself. Be resourceful and practical, dealing with issues as they arise using straightforward solutions that fix the problem with minimal fuss.

Virgos are always paying attention to the smallest details and their deep sense of humanity makes them one of the most careful signs of the Zodiac. Virgos are practical, analytical, and hard-working. They always know exactly where to look for the core of any problem. Virgo stands for all practical and used things, and it is in the nature of these individuals to save money and always put something on the side. Not only do you identify opportunities for growth and success, but you also draw upon your self-discipline and control to manage your wealth and invest it wisely for the long-term. Through diligence, responsibility, and attention to detail, you have achieved great things. King of Pentacles often indicates the final fulfillment of a creative task, a business venture, or investment.
